Terms of Enrollment

- A \$800 deposit accompanies this form.
- The tuition provides for the program with the exception of the optional Canadian adventures and the camp store account.
- Enrollment may be cancelled prior to December 1, 2009 with all payments refunded less a \$75 administrative fee.
- For cancellations after December 1, 2009 a refund will be made with the exception of the initial Deposit which will be directed to the Camp Chippewa Scholarship Fund. No refund will be made for cancellations on or after April 15th, 2010.
- There is no discount for late arrival or early departure.
- Travel to and from camp is the parents' responsibility. For your convenience, there is a chartered bus to and from the Minneapolis airport. The fare for the chartered bus is included in the camp tuition.
- Campers who qualify on the basis of age and camping experience may be selected for the Chippewa Leadership Training Program. Ask for this information if your son is entering his junior or senior year in high school.

Camper Conduct Policy

Camp Chippewa will admit campers of any race, color, or creed to all rights, privileges and activities generally accorded or made available. Campers and parents are expected to read and fully understand all material pertaining to Camp policies so that our expectations are made clear. Campers are required to accept and follow these policies. If these policies are not followed, the camper may be dismissed, and there will be no refund of tuition.

- There will be no use of tobacco, alcohol, or controlled substances. Use of any of these substances will result in dismissal.
- If a camper's conduct is such that the director determines that his presence is detrimental to others or to the camp community, the camper will be dismissed. In such case there will be no refund of tuition.
- Do not send your son to camp if he has any problem with bed wetting.
- Campers and staff are expected to attend a non-denominational Sunday chapel service.
- Campers are expected to treat each other with respect and to follow camp health & safety policies and regulations.
- Campers are expected to have a neat appearance at all times. Hair style and clothing must be reasonable. Jewelry associated with body piercing is not allowed.
