- The tuition is all-inclusive and provides for the entire program and includes optional Canadian trips (*see reverse side*.)
- The deposit of \$100 for the camp store account is payable on June 1st.
- Enrollment may be cancelled prior to December 1, 2011, with all payments refunded less a \$75 administrative fee.
- For cancellations after December 1, 2011, a refund will be made with the exception of the initial deposit which will be directed to the *Camp Chippewa Scholarship Fund*. No refund will be made for cancellations on or after April 15, 2012.
- There is no discount for late arrival or early departure.
- Please contact the camp office prior to enrolling if your son has problems with bed wetting.
- Travel to and from camp is the parents' responsibility. For your convenience, there is a chartered bus or van to and from Camp and the Minneapolis-St. Paul airport. The fare for the chartered bus or van is included in the camp tuition.
- Campers who qualify on the basis of age and camping experience may be selected for the Chippewa Leadership Training Program. Ask for this information if your son is entering his junior or senior year in high school.

Travel Convenience

To accommodate our families and to make flight reservations easier, we are delighted to again be working with **Travel One** of Minneapolis, phone (800) 245-1111. They will coordinate flights, work for lowest fares, and keep us apprised of schedules. You may choose to make your own travel arrangements. All planes for will be met by our staff at the Minneapolis-St. Paul Airport. There will be a chartered bus to and from Camp and the Minneapolis Airport on the first and last days of each session. The cost for the bus is included in the tuition. Special trips to Bemidji or trips to the airport for late arrival or early departure are charged \$35.00. (over please →)

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Optional Canadian and Lake Superior Adventures

Four week campers entering 6th grade or higher qualify for participation in these special trips into Canada or the Lake Superior Sail Trip.

Hook Island Adventure	Open to boys entering 6th & 7th grades.
Voyageurs National Park Canoe Trip	Open to boys entering 8th grade
Introductory Canadian Canoe Trip	Open to boys entering 9th grade.
Exploratory Canadian Canoe Trip	An extended trip open to older boys and to those who have been on the Introductory Trip.
Lake Superior-Apostle Island Sail Cruise	Open to sailors age 11 to 14.
Combination of any of the above	An 8-week camper may choose a combination of the above.

Hudson Bay Account

At the camp store, the Hudson Bay Trading Post, campers may purchase various items such as fishing tackle, toilet articles, candy and Camp Chippewa clothing. Any out-of-camp activities such as Bemidji Day will be charged to this account. The purchase of special or expensive items requires prior parental permissions. We recommend a \$100 deposit for the camp store, due with the June 1st payment. At the end of the summer, a bill will be forwarded to you with either a request for payment or a refund for any unused funds.

Other Items

Laundry service is provided weekly. The cost of the laundry is included in the tuition. Clothes that require special handling are not covered and will be charged a special fee.

Our Health/Accident Insurance policy covers medical, dental, and pharmaceutical charges to the limits of the policy. Each boy will have this coverage, for which there is no additional charge. We emphasize safety at all times but do not assume liability for accident, pre-existing conditions or illness. Routine aid furnished by the camp's medical staff is provided at no charge.

A 1.5% per month service charge is made on overdue accounts.
